



Arrival and Departure Information And Camp Driving Directions

Arrival

- □ All campers should arrive at Camp between 3:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Friday, August 5, 2022.
- \Box For safety purposes, campers will not be allowed on the premises before 3:00 p.m.
- □ Please <u>be prepared to stay in your car</u> for 15 minutes or more while your child's COVID-19 test is processed (if conditions warrant). After a negative test is determined, plan to stay with your child through medical check-in to ensure that all questions are answered.
- □ If your camper is riding the bus, you must be on time. If you are late, the bus cannot wait, and you will be responsible for your child's transportation to camp.

Departure

- □ A special session for parents and caregivers will be held on Sunday from 11 a.m. to 12 p.m. This is optional, but we hope that you will take advantage of this opportunity to talk with our trained staff about the Camp Cocoon experience and caring for a child who has lost a loved one.
- □ Campers <u>must</u> be checked out by Camp Personnel and Nurses before they will be allowed to leave. Check out will begin at 12 p.m.
- □ All campers must be picked up <u>no later than 12:30 p.m. on Sunday, August 7, 2022.</u>
- □ If your camper is <u>riding the bus</u> home, please plan to arrive at the pick-up location <u>30 minutes</u> <u>prior</u> to the arrival of the bus to complete check-out before your camper arrives.

Directions

Athens Y Girls Camp at Tallulah Falls is located in Northeast Georgia and is accessible via US Highway 441. From Atlanta:

- Take I-85 North to I-985 North
 - I-985 turns into GA 365 and then turns into US 441 (near the Toccoa exit)
- Follow 985/365/441 for approximately 64.9 miles
- Shortly after you cross Tallulah Gorge (1/10th mile), you will see a big, white sign on the left side of the road that says *Athens Y Camp*. Just past the sign look for Terrora Circle.
- Turn left on Terrora Circle
- Turn right at stop sign, Old 441
- Go 2 miles and turn left on Y Camp Road
- Follow Y Camp Road to the entrance of the Camp.

If your child is running a fever or experiencing any of the symptoms of COVID-19, your child will not be eligible for camp, so please do not bring your child to camp or to the bus pick-up location.
