## **Special Items to Bring**

- $\Box$  Photos of camper's deceased loved one that can be used in various craft projects.
- □ A favorite article of clothing from the camper's deceased loved one (if available) that can be sewn into a comfort pillow. (For example, a favorite t-shirt that can be cut and sewn into the shape of a heart then stuffed to make a pillow.) The items you provide for making the pillow should be very meaningful to the camper and their relationship with their loved one.

- $\Box$  Bath towel
- $\Box$  Toothbrush
- □ Toothpaste□ Comb/brush
- $\Box$  Deodorant
- □ Feminine products
- □ Sheets & blanket (or sleeping bag)
- □ Pillow & pillowcase
- $\Box$  Flashlight
- □ Insect repellent

- □ Hand sanitizer
- $\Box$  Beach towel
- $\Box$  Sunscreen
- □ Swimsuit
  - Girls: modest one-piece swimsuit
  - Boys: swim trunks or board shorts

Please do not pack shirts. We will provide a fresh Camp Cocoon t-shirt for your camper each day.

Do <u>Not</u> Bring (These items will be confiscated and held until the end of camp)

- Food/candy
- Cell phone/Smart phone
- Electronic devices of any kind: handheld games, music players/headphones, radio, etc.
- Knives/weapons
- Firecrackers/fireworks

- Electric fan
- Camera (We will have a staff photographer)
- Drugs, or any medication that has not been checked in by medical personnel.
- Tobacco products of <u>any</u> kind.

## **Baggage Policy**

We have a 3-bag limit for each camper (**or** 2 bags plus a sleeping bag). We believe this reduces the number of misplaced items and is especially helpful to younger campers and their house parents.

For returning campers, prior to camp, please remove all Camp Cocoon baggage tags from your child's luggage left over from previous years.
